









# **BLOOD DONATION CAMPAIGN**

PARKING: free of charge, directly in front of the building or side street (karriere.at parking spaces)

All healthy **persons over the age of 18** can donate blood at **8-week intervals**. The health questionnaire to be filled out before donating blood and the subsequent confidential discussion with our doctor serve both **the safety of our blood products and the safety of the blood donors**. Please bring an **official photo ID** and **your blood donor card** to the blood donation. The laboratory results will be sent to you approx. 8 weeks later, so that the blood donation also becomes a small health check for you. You should eat at least one small meal and drink enough fluids in the last 3-4 hours before donating blood and avoid physical exertion after donating blood.

# **DONATE BLOOD - SAVE LIVES!**

### **General Information**

#### You must not donate blood if any of the following apply:

- "fever blister"
- open wound, fresh injury
- acute allergy
- sick leave and cure

#### In the last 48 hours:

- One vaccination with inactivated vaccine e.g. TBE, influenza, diphtheria, tetanus, polio, meningococcal, hepatitis A/-B, covid-10
- Non-bloody dental procedures.

## In the last 3 days:

 Desensitization treatment (allergies).

#### In the last 7 days:

- Scaling
- Tooth extraction
- · Root canal treatment

#### In the last 4 weeks:

- Infectious diseases (influenza infection intestinal infection or diarrhea, etc.).
- A vaccination with live vaccine, e.g. measles mumps, rubella, BCG. etc.
- Taking antibiotics

#### In the last 2 months:

- Tick bite

#### In the last 4 months:

- Piercing, tattooing, ear piercing, acupuncture outside of doctor's office, permanent make up
- Gastroscopy, colonoscopy
- Contact with HIV, hepatitis-B, -C

#### In the last 6 months:

• - Stay in malaria areas
